

PLACEMENT CRITERIA FOR THE DORMITORY

The following ground rules are followed in the evaluation of the applications for OMU International Students Dormitory:

1. Priority is given to accommodate students coming within the scope of an international exchange programme such as Mevlana, Erasmus+, etc.
2. In the event that there is space available in the dormitory following the accommodation of the exchange programme students, other applicant international students are accommodated.
3. Turkish students can also be accommodated in the dormitory in the event that there is space available in the dormitory following the placements of the above mentioned international students as of the end of the second week of the semester. Priority is given to postgraduate students in such a case.

The following criteria are applied in the evaluation of the applications for OMU International Students Dormitory:

1. No criteria will be applied to exchange programme students.
2. In the accommodation of other international students and Turkish students, each group will be evaluated in itself and placed in accordance with the following criteria:
 - a) Student placement score for students who have newly enrolled in a higher education programme,
 - b) Weighted grade point average for students studying above the 1st grade. In case of an equality, the student placement score,
 - c) In case of an equality following the evaluation, the student who is younger will be placed.
 - d) Students who have a priority certificate (For Turkish students)
 - Students who have lost one or both of their parents.
 - Children of martyrs are given 10; children of veterans are given 5 additional points.
 - Students who have a disability rate over 40% are given 5 additional points.
